

THE CONCEPT:

A health system based on providing health in place enabled by module mobile units—the bees—will advance health in our communities. A regional mover will expand the reach of these autonomous pods, shuttling them to more remote locations. Through high-tech capabilities these pods connect to a hospital hub, both virtually and physically, creating an interconnected but decentralized health system. The mobile clinic pods will be accessible anywhere they are needed. By triaging lower acuity needs at home via the pod, the model encourages greater frequency of check-ups and increased focus on prevention. The supportive ecosystem creates hope, healing and help.
