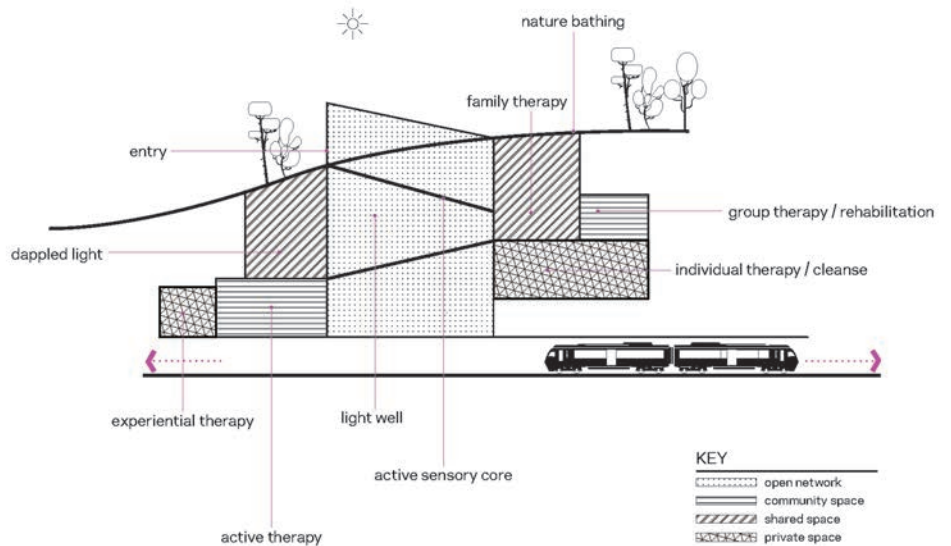

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THE CONCEPT:

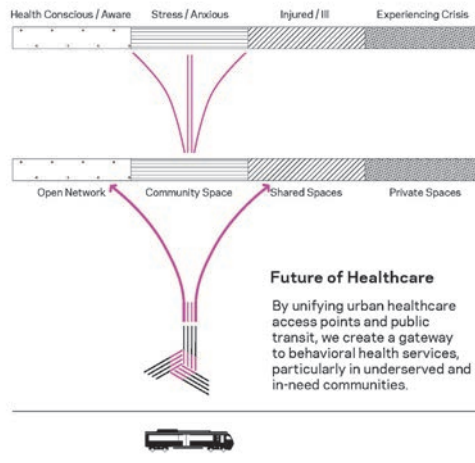
Living Place is a new approach and framework to address gaps in healthcare access and provide users with decision making skills. Living Place is a network of healthcare access points addressing the gaps of today's segmented healthcare system. This network utilizes current public transit infrastructure to weave healthcare into daily routines. Our design outlines the concept for one access point of the Living Place network, focused on improving behavioral and mental health in an underserved and in-need Seattle community. Various points throughout Living Place allow for users to assess their well-being and select their next step towards a positive healing experience. By traveling through a vertical core, individuals encounter decision nodes to help them understand their care options and which path best suits their needs. This process of reflection on mental well-being as part of a daily routine helps increase transparency and reduces the stigma surrounding behavioral health.
